## FIRE EXTINGUISHER FAQ'S

### How do I use a fire extinguisher?

PASS: Pull the pin, Aim the nozzle at the base of the fire, Squeeze the handle to spray, Sweep from side to side until it goes out. Watch closely and repeat aim, squeeze, and sweep if the fire reignites.

### Are fire extinguishers toxic?

You probably don't want to breathe in a lungful of any fire extinguisher chemicals if you can possibly avoid it, but a standard ABC extinguisher's contents will typically cause mild irritation at worst. Class K wet chemical extinguishers, on the other hand, can contain much more toxic chemical components, and any direct exposure should be taken seriously.

### Can a fire extinguisher explode?


Defective or heavily damaged fire extinguishers have been known to explode, making it especially important that you get your extinguishers inspected regularly and take care if one is damaged to replace it.

Fires caused by flammable metals like lithium should be extinguished using a Class D extinguisher!



## CLASS K

Fires caused in the kitchen by grease or hot oils should be extinguished using a Class K extinguisher!


## CLASS A

Fires that are perpetuated by wood, cloth, paper, or plastic should be extinguished using a Class A extinguisher!



## CLASS B

Fires using flammable liquids like gasoline should be extinguished using a Class B extinguisher!



## CLASS C

Electrical fires for wiring and appliances should be extinguished using a Class C extinguisher!
