Pediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS)


PALS is for providers who respond to emergencies in infants and children and for personnel in emergency response, emergency medicine, intensive care and critical care units.

ADULT FIRST AID & CPR

The goal of this training program is for participants to gain or improve knowledge and skill proficiency in adult first aid and/or CPR AED for adult, child, and infant. This program includes flexible instructional tools for developing proficiency via demonstration and prompted practice, including scenario-based problem-solving exercises with feedback.

The course reflects the latest resuscitation science and treatment recommendations published by the International Liaison Committee on Resuscitation (ILCOR), and it conforms with the 2020 American Heart Association (AHA) Guidelines Update for CPR and ECC and the annual Guidelines Update.

The intended audience is individuals who are not healthcare providers or professional rescuers who desire, or are occupationally required, to be trained and certified in adult first aid.

FOR EVERYONE

Anyone who desires, or is occupationally required, to be trained and certified in adult first aid can take this course.



BCLS

Basic Cardiac Life Support (BCLS)

Our BCLS certification teaches emergency life saving interventions such as cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR), how to work an automated external defibrillator (AED), and how to respond when a person is choking.

The AHA's BLS course trains participants to promptly recognize several life-threatening emergencies, give high-quality chest compressions, deliver appropriate ventilations and provide early use of an AED. Reflects science and education from the American Heart.

This is intended for the healthcare or professional rescuer field that are required to have completed a professional-level basic life support training course.



ACLS

Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS)

This is an American Heart Association program that we can put on for EMT's, Paramedics, Nurses and Doctors and most require it when working in hospitals. It is a hands on training program consisting of lectures and then practical stations. The ACLS Recert class is an 8 hour class while a full provider class is 16 hours.
